


How to use IScored.Today for scoring


- 1) Navigate to <https://iscored.today/>
 - a. Note you can make this a shortcut (add to Home screen) on your phone



- 2) For CAC events, we generally only use the "Login to Event" option, so choose that one

- 3) On the next screen, choose the event from the drop-down menu
 - a. Enter the Archers name
 - b. Enter the passcode
 - i. For CAC events, the format is “CAC” + DDMM, eg CAC2505


Now that only events **for today** will be listed and can be scored





- 4) Then from the list of registered archers, select those that will be scoring together on your device.
- a. There may be more than just yourself, as you may be entering scores for someone else shooting on your target, or someone on an adjacent target.
 - b. Usually it will be just those (1-3) people on your target.
 - c. Anyone showing as red/locked has already been selected (by you or someone else)
 - d. Then press START



- 5) Now click on the names to order the scoring
- convention is left to right on the line, in the example below Rachel would be standing on the left of Byron
 - Press Scoring to commence

6) Initially you'll see the progressive score page, so to start scoring press ADD SCORES

- 7) Enter the value of each arrow, in descending order
- If you've made a mistake, you can click the value on the left to remove & replace it
 - Press NEXT when all 6 arrows are scored, and repeat for the next archer.
